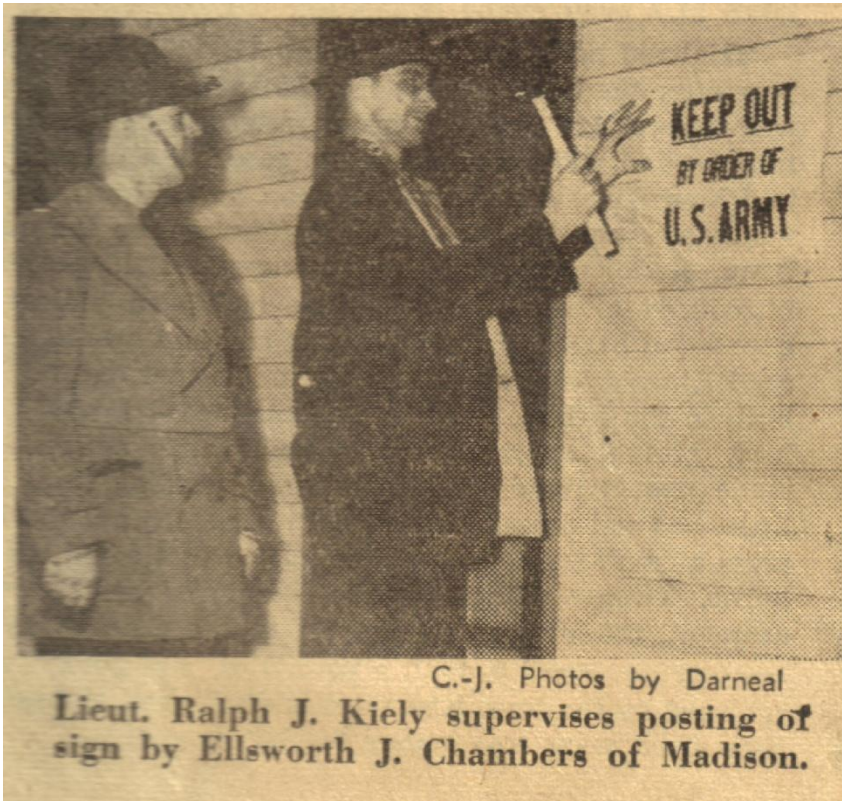

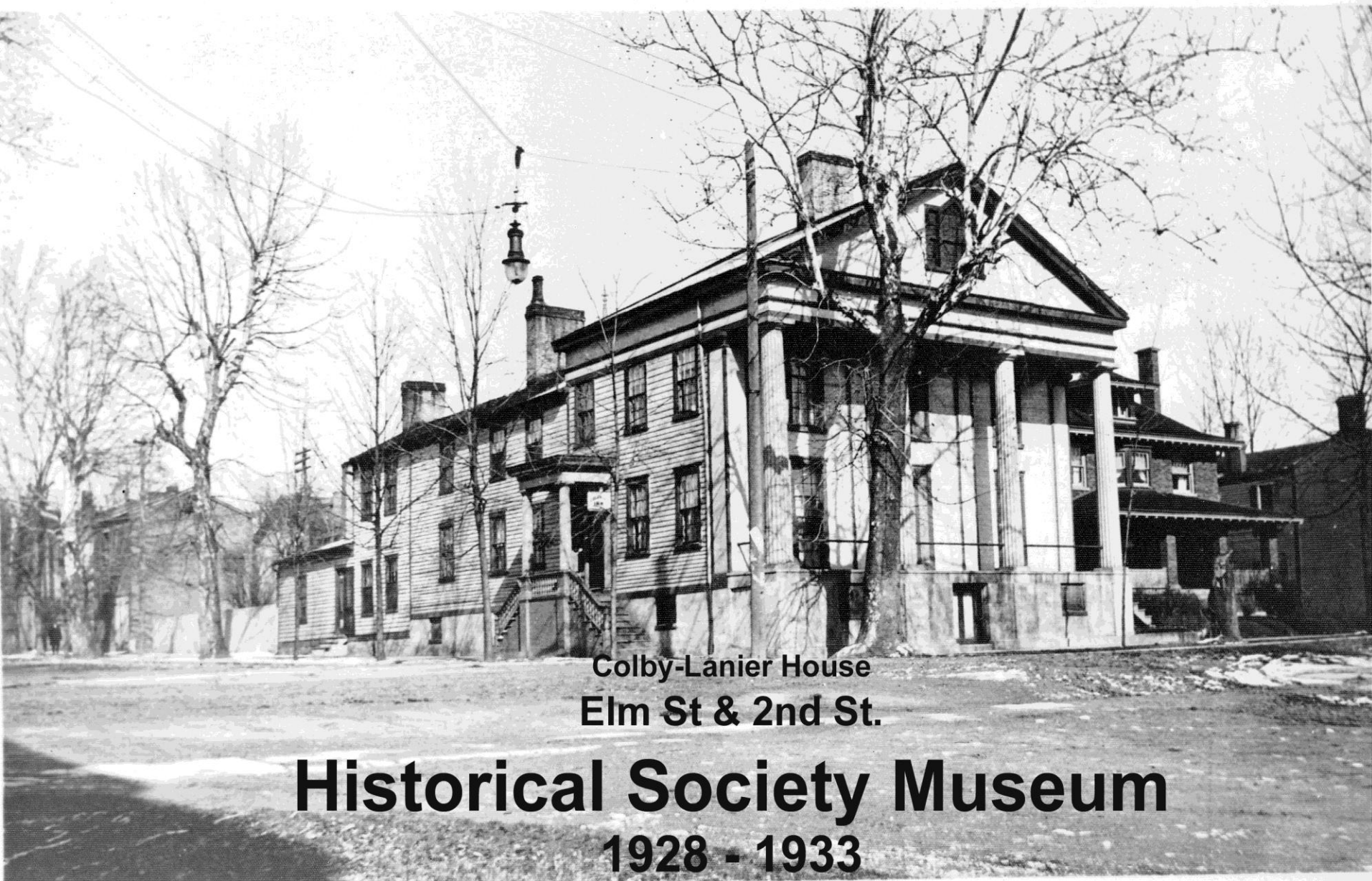
The Jefferson County Historical Society was chartered in 1850.

Society. No records exist prior to the early 1900's.

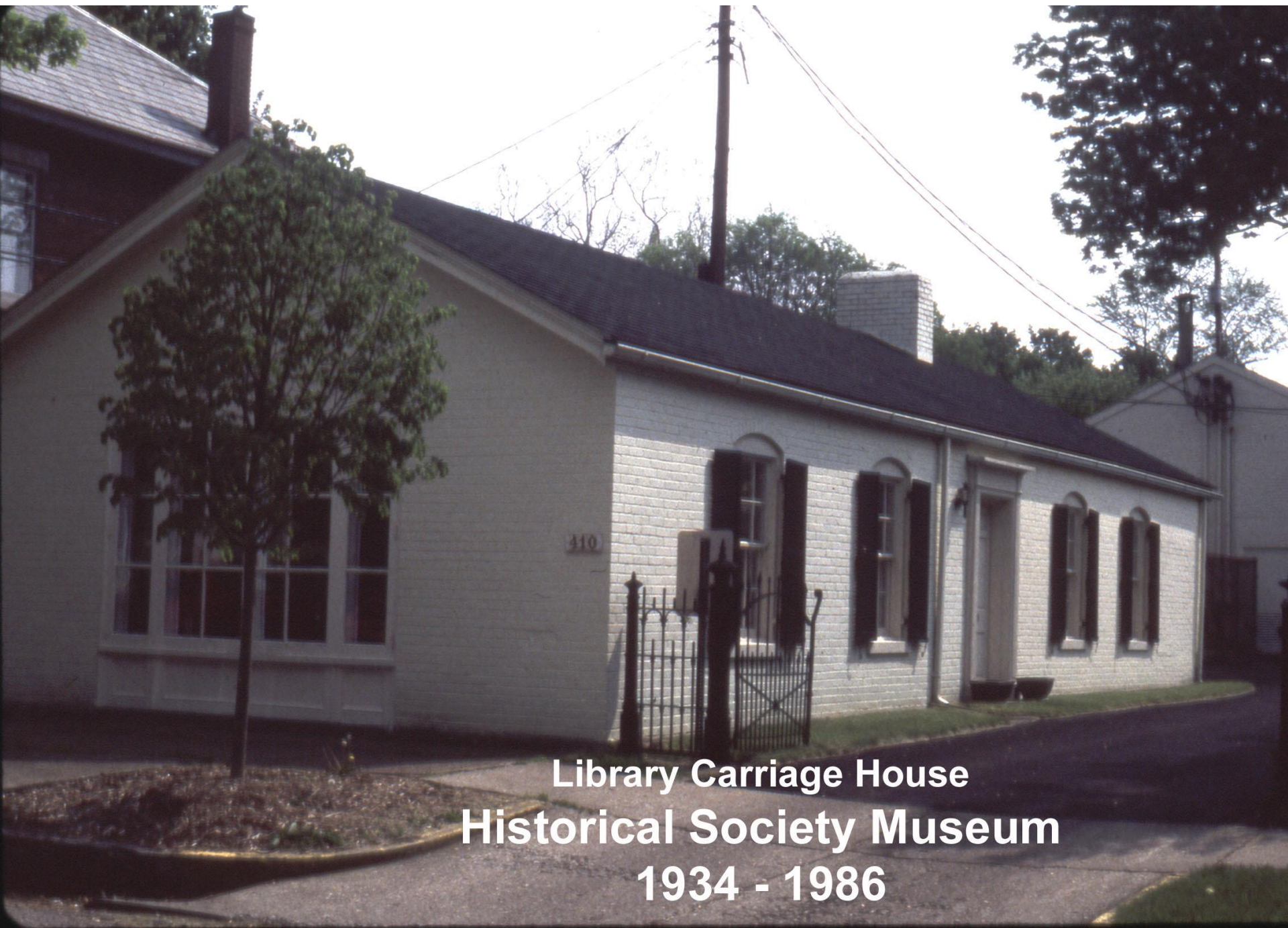
